
2.0 UTILITY CHARGE (NON-REFUNDABLE)


Electricity Service Charge (per annum)	£54.00

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2.1 CLEARANCE FEE

This fee applies for the removal and disposal of abandoned items left on moorings following a berth cancellation.	£94.00
A disposal fee may also be applied.	





TERMS OF PAYMENT

- Invoices will be raised for each transaction of business between a customer and Guernsey Ports and must be settled within 30 days of the date of the invoice. - 2. Guernsey Ports does not permit any right of offset against any other account without prior written agreement.
- 3. Settlement of invoices may be made by:

 - BACS transfer (annual invoices only) to "National Westminster Bank", Sort Code: 60-09-20, Account Number: 74121677. Please include your 8 digit account number (1******) and invoice number (9******) as a reference.

 - Credit/Debit Card by phone at Frossard House (contact 01481 220015).
 - Cash or Credit/Debit in person at Edward T Wheadon House
 - Direct Debit, subject to approval by the Marine Service Centre, either monthly or annually.
- 4. Any invoice not paid in full by the due date shall be subject to an interest charge at a rate of 4 percent per annum over the Bank of England base rate in respect of the period for which the fees were overdue.
- 5. If accounts are not fully paid within the prescribed period, the States of Guernsey reserves the right to seek recovery of the outstanding amount, which may result in legal proceedings being commenced.
